Prof Danie Veldsman, Head of the Department of Dogmatics and Christian Ethics in the Faculty of Theology at the University of Pretoria, cordially invites you to a public lecture presented by German Protestant theologian Prof Jürgen Moltmann. He is emeritus professor of Theology at Tübingen University (1994-).

This event forms part of Professor Moltmann's visit to the Faculty of Theology where he will receive an honorary doctorate (DD Honoris Causa) from the Department of Dogmatics and Christian Ethics for the contribution he has made to theological reflection for more than fifty years.

Prof Moltmann has been described as 'one of the most influential Christian thinkers' of our time and

the 'ecumenical theologian of hope for this world'. His work in post WWII history of theology in Europe, North America and even Africa and Asia is unparalleled. He is the most widely read, quoted and translated theologian of our time. His works are taught, read or engaged with in almost all theological faculties and seminaries of note in the West and East, in North and South. There is not a single contemporary theological textbook in Systematic Theology that is internationally recognised by Protestants and Roman Catholics alike that does not give extensive attention to the theological contribution of Professor Moltmann.

His systematic work thrives on the cutting edge of Christian theology in the 21st century, challenging and stimulating a whole generation of theologians to work at theology differently and more comprehensively.
